

Interview with Jaclyn Mothupi, Associate Director of Social Innovations at Wond'ry Innovation Center, Vanderbilt University. Formerly Regional Director of External Affairs, TN Dept of Environment and Conservation (April 2020)

Q: What are you are working on as part of the Mayor's Sustainability Advisory Committee?

A: Serving as Co-Chair on the Adaptation Committee which is responsible for drafting the Adaptation Plan within Nashville's Climate Action Plan
