

**METROPOLITAN NASHVILLE-DAVIDSON COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION LICENSING COMMISSION**

**Minutes
March 24, 2022**

The Metropolitan Nashville-Davidson County Transportation Licensing Commission (TLC) met for a regular meeting on this date in the Jury Assembly Room of the Historic Davidson County Courthouse. Present were Vice Chair Patrick McNally and Commissioners Mona Lisa Warren, Freddie Carr, Michael Hayes, Betsy Williams and Carol Westlake (6). Present were Metro Legal Adviser Theresa Costonis with TLC staff members Lisa Steelman, TD Schlafer and Billy Fields.

In the absence of the Chair, the Vice Chair called the meeting to order then led the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a reading of the Notice of Appeal Statement which outlined the right of appeal of TLC decisions.

After some decision, Commissioner Carr with a second from Commissioner Hayes moved to begin accepting application for Entertainment Transportation companies on Monday, March 28, 2022 and set noon on Friday April 15, 2022 as the deadline to submit applications.

Commissioner Williams asked if the Commission could hold a workshop/work session for entertainment transportation industry. After some explanation from Legal Advisor Costonis, Commissioner Williams with a second from Commissioner Hayes moved to hold a workshop on either April 12 or 13.

After some discussion, Commissioner Williams with a second from Commissioner Westlake to hold a special meeting on May 11 to consider Entertainment Transportation applications.
