Hazen and Sawyer

Strengths

Proposal demonstrated firm's Water experience. Proposal demonstrated firm's experience in acquired easements. Proposal demonstrated local presence for firm's proposed key team members dedicated to Metro, including CMAR. Proposal demonstrated firm's ARP funding experience. Firm provided detailed subcontractor information. Firm provided a detailed schedule, noting Schrader as number one project. Proposal demonstrated a detailed schedule and long control deadline plan. Firm proposed extra time in phase one to build blue print for remaining projects. Proposal provided detailed design storm pro's and con's for design approach. Proposal demonstrated firm's thorough site assessment. Firm proposed a high degree of innovation. Firm provided maps. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Proposal failed to demonstrate team/subcontractor collaborations. Proposal demonstrated limited experience for CMAR lead, only listed one project for experience. Proposal demonstrated limited separation experience for key team members. Proposal lacked detail for GIS staffing. Proposal demonstrated potential limited capacity to perform due to CMAR being listed on another ongoing project. Proposal lacked detail for quality assurance/quality control. Proposal lacked detail for water lines approach.

Kimley-Horn & Assoc Inc

Strengths

Proposal demonstrated team member's specialized experiences. Proposal demonstrated firm's experience on Metro projects, Casey Homes Project (MDHA). Proposal demonstrated a detailed trash and emergency services plan. Firm proposed a design team lead for each basin. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Proposal failed to demonstrate team/subcontractor collaborations. Team lead experience was unclear and lacked detail for separation experience. Proposal demonstrated no local presences for key team members and proposed a low percentage dedicated to Metro. Proposal lacked detail for project manager's separation experience. Proposal demonstrated limited CMAR experience and lacked detail. Reference project contact only provided feedback for firm's subcontractor. Firm's reference project roles were unclear. Proposal demonstrated potential limited capacity to perform due to other large ongoing projects. Proposal failed to address progressive approach. Proposal failed to demonstrate and address ARP funding experience. Proposal referenced non-capable software. Proposal provided a generic schedule. Proposal failed to demonstrate firm's understanding of scope of work. Proposal lacked detail for water lines approach. Firm's proposed project approach lacked detail. Proposal failed to address design storm.

Stantec

Strengths

Proposed 90% of project manager's time to Metro. Provided reference projects demonstrating separation experience. Provided a detailed data collection plan. Proposal provided detailed design storm pro's and con's for design approach. Firm proposed a detailed innovation plan. Firm provided maps. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Proposal failed to demonstrate team/subcontractor collaborations. Deputy project manager and design lead separation experience was unclear and lacked detail. Proposal demonstrated no local presences for lead project manager and key team members, causes potential logistical issues for Metro. Proposal lacked detail for project manager's separation experience. Proposal lacked detail demonstrated separation experience for proposed CMAR. Provided site assessment lacked detail. Proposed schedule not realistic, phase three lacked detail.
