Present were Metro Legal Adviser Theresa Costonis with NDOT Director Diana Alarcon, NDOT Assistant Director Phillip Jones, NDOT William Robinson, TLC staff members Lisa Steelman, TD Schlafer and Billy Fields.

The Chair called the meeting to order then led the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a reading of the Notice of Appeal Statement which outlined the right of appeal of TLC decisions.

Commissioner Carr with a second from Commissioner Rogers moved approval of the meeting minutes from June 23, 2022.
