East Bank Stadium

Relevant legislation includes:

- RS2022-1827: A resolution approving a term sheet describing the terms and conditions
  of the agreements and transactions required to finance, construct, and operate a new,
  enclosed multi-purpose stadium on the East Bank, subject to the subsequent approval
  of final agreements, and authorizing the Metropolitan Government to pursue other
  matters related thereto.
- BL2022-1529: An ordinance amending Chapter 5.12 of the Metropolitan Code of Laws pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 67-4-1415 by increasing the hotel occupancy privilege tax in the amount of one percent and directing the proceeds be used for the construction of and future capital improvements to a new enclosed stadium, and debt service related thereto.

We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.
