- 03-23-04** Staff requests approval of a Permit for Use of Park Space for the Cul2vate Community Garden of the Mill Ridge Park, 12924 Old Hickory Blvd, Antioch, TN 37013, to garden at Mill Ridge Park. The permit is for a period of one year contingent upon all permit obligations being met (copies of the permit will be available for review at the board meeting).
- 03-23-05** HoopBus in partnership with Vanderbilt University Athletics requests the acceptance of an in-kind grant valued at approximately \$60,000 to renovate and restore the Watkins Park basketball court. The renovation includes newly renovated asphalt, hoops, and nets. It also includes mural artwork by local artists and students. There is no required match or other obligation by Parks associated with this grant.
- 03-23-06** Staff requests acceptance of an in-kind grant valued at approximately \$27,500 from the West Nashville Sports League for new fencing/gates, scoreboards, infield work on Baseball Fields 1 and 2 also, additional fencing/gates in the back Baseball Fields 3, 4 and 5 in Warner Park. There is no required match or other obligation by Parks associated with this grant.

- 03-23-09** Piedmont Natural Gas Co. Inc. (PNG Co. Inc.), request a 1.103-acre permanent utility easement for installation of one or more new underground pipelines across property owned by Metro (0 Hwy 70 South/Parcel #14200021700).
