Description of Claims:

Plaintiff brought claims of violations of Title IX and Section 1983 against Metro relating to alleged sexual harassment by a male student at Whites Creek High School in 2029-2020.

Procedural Posture:

With Metropolitan Nashville Board of Education approval, the Department of Law presented Plaintiff with a Rule 68 offer of judgment in the amount of \$8,000 plus attorney's fees and costs. Plaintiff accepted the offer and judgment was entered.
