- 06-23-02** Board to approve open range salary increase and cost of living salary increase, consistent with Metro employees for the Director of Parks as per the 2023-24 Metropolitan Government Pay Plan.
- 06-23-03** Friends of Warner Parks requests acceptance of an in-kind grant not to exceed \$1,027,489 to fund the next phase of improvements in Warner Parks. There is no required match or other obligation by Parks associated with this grant.
- 06-23-04** Creative Parks Nashville requests acceptance of an in-kind grant of equipment approximately valued at \$12,500 for support and expansion of the Music and Visual Arts programs. There is no required match or other obligation by Parks associated with this grant.

The projects include a pole barn, apiary installation, water catchment station, community garden plots, and other site improvements. - 06-23-06** Vanderbilt University Athletics Department requests acceptance of an in-kind grant valued at approximately \$152,596 to replace the current video board at Centennial Sportsplex. There is no required match or other obligation by Parks associated with this grant. The project will be paid for directly by Vanderbilt University Athletics.
- 06-23-07** Staff requests approval of a Memorandum of Understanding between Metro Parks, Metropolitan Nashville Police Department (MNPD) and General Services to operate on a portion of the property located at Peeler Park (2043 Neely's Bend Road, Madison, TN 37115). The shared space includes pasture space, a horse barn, training space, arenas, and other amenities. General Services will maintain the facilities outlined within the conceptual site map.
