Mr. Cheek informed the Board of measures implemented to ensure there would be no violations of the Noise Ordinance such as, Music would be lowered, and announcements made from 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave to Lafayette St; A noise meter would be utilized to periodically check the volume; A sound engineer would check the system once a week and the amps would be set at the appropriate volume and secured. The Board also made note that CM Sledge agreed with the stated measures, per his email communication. After hearing all, Mr. Perlen made a motion to grant final approval. Ms. Jarmon seconded the motion to grant final approval.

12/19/22 - Email received. Applicant is Surrendering the Beer Permit

01/20/23 – Inspector Webb visits the location. No beer found being sold or stored on premises. Permittee stated he does not desire to attend the 1/25/23 Beer Board Meeting.

Following Chairman Taylor's reading of the complaint. The Board was informed the beer permit had been surrendered on 12/19/22. Inspector Webb visited the location on 1/20/23 to ensure there was no beer sales or storage on the premises. There was neither found at the time of her visit. Inspector Webb stated she informed the permit holder of the upcoming requested Beer Board Hearing and the subject stated he did not desire to attend. The Board then had a brief discussion

with Beer Board Attorney Matthew Garth to ensure the permit holder fully understood that surrender of the beer permit does not excuse the violation nor the Board's authority to act on the violation. The Board decided to defer the hearing to Beer Board Meeting 2/22/23, to allow the permit holder to be present. It was also discussed, that in future instances, such as this, where a permit holder surrenders the beer permit, Inspectors/Staff should require the permit holder to sign a statement stating they understand that surrendering the beer permit does not excuse the complaint or the Beer Board's authority to act upon it. Ms. Perry made a motion to defer the hearing to February 22, 2023. The motion was seconded by Mr. Perlen. The Board voted unanimously to approve the motion.

M.C.L 7.08.140R It is unlawful for any beer permit holder or his agent or employee to allow or engage in any criminal activity on the premises Section 39-17-1504 - Sale or distribution to underage persons unlawful - Proof of age requirement - (d) A person engaged in the sale or distribution of tobacco, smoking hemp, or vapor products shall demand proof of age from a prospective purchaser or recipient if an ordinary person would conclude on the basis of appearance that the prospective purchaser or recipient may be under thirty (30) years of age on or about September 20, 2022).
