December 7, 2023

The Metropolitan Nashville-Davidson County Transportation Licensing Commission (TLC) met for its regular meeting on this date in the Jury Assembly Room of the Historic Davidson County Courthouse. Present were Vice Chair Pat McNally, Commissioners Freddie Carr, Michael Hayes, Carol Westlake, Trey Reliford and Michael Santistevan (6). Also present were NDOT Director Diana Alarcon along with NDOT Staff Lisa Steelman, Richard Rooker, Amanda Mullins and Billy Fields. Also present was Metro Legal advisors Erica Haber and Theresa Costonis.

The Vice Chair called the meeting to order then led the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a reading of the Notice of Appeal Statement which outlined the right of appeal of TLC decisions.
