An ordinance authorizing the naming of Unnumbered Alley right-of-way, from Benton Avenue to Craighead Street, as “Coliseum Way”. (Proposal Number 2024M-001SR-001).




Figure 1: Parcel map showing location of Unnumbered (aka Unnamed) Alley. Exhibit for 2024M-001SR-001 (cropped). Source: Metropolitan Planning Department.




Figure 2: Page 12 of Exhibit A from BL2021-964, showing site plan for Proposed Alley. Source: Metro Government Legislative Information Center, Metropolitan Clerk’s Office.

The subject Unnumbered Alley was dedicated by ordinance BL2021-964, An ordinance declaring certain planned roads on the Nashville Fairgrounds campus to be public rights of way (Proposal No. 2021 M-019PR-001) (Figs. 1 and 2). Upon passage of the legislation,

Metropolitan Government accepted several roads for maintenance and as public rights of way, including the subject alley, which was identified as “Proposed Alley,” and future extensions of Wedgewood Avenue and Benton Avenue, which were under construction at the time. The legislation does not appear to contain an explanation as to why the alley was not named or numbered. Metropolitan Council passed BL2021-964 at third Reading on November 16, 2021. Mayor John Cooper approved the ordinance on November 17, 2021.
