## **Change of Address**

If you have moved within Davidson County and not updated your address, visit GoVoteTN (https://ovr.govote.tn.gov), a secure site where you can submit a change.

## **Absentee Voting by Mail**

- For voters aged 60 or older
- For voters with other qualifying reasons, as listed on the Request form found at https://www.nashville.gov/vote or by calling (615) 862-8815
- Requests for an Absentee Ballot must be received by Thursday, July 25, 2024

### **Election Day Voting Hours**

The polls are open 7:00 am - 7:00 pm on Election Day.

\*\*\*You must vote at your assigned location on Election Day \*\*\*

- Check your voter registration card OR
- Check the Polling Place Finder https://maps.nashville.gov/PollingPlaceFinder OR
- Call the Election Commission (615) 862-8800 for your Election Day voting location.

Note: There are no assigned Early Voting locations. Early Voting ends July 27.

### **Photo ID**

You must present a photo ID issued by the federal or Tennessee state government, unless exemption applies.

### **Choosing a Ballot**

This is a primary election. When Early Voting, you can indicate your ballot preference by pointing to the table sign at check-in. On Election Day, you can make your selection on the Electronic Poll Book.
