Absentee Voting by Mail

- For voters aged 60 or older
- For voters with other qualifying reasons, as listed on the Request form found at <https://www.nashville.gov/vote> or by calling **(615) 862-8815**
- Requests for an Absentee Ballot must be received by **Thursday, July 25, 2024**

Election Day Voting Hours

The polls are open 7:00 am – 7:00 pm on Election Day.

******You must vote at your assigned location on Election Day******

- Check your voter registration card OR
- Check the Polling Place Finder <https://maps.nashville.gov/PollingPlaceFinder> OR
- Call the Election Commission **(615) 862-8800** for your Election Day voting location.

Note: There are no assigned Early Voting locations. Early Voting ends July 27.

Photo ID

You must present a photo ID issued by the federal or Tennessee state government, unless exemption applies.

Choosing a Ballot

This is a primary election. When Early Voting, you can indicate your ballot preference by pointing to the table sign at check-in. On Election Day, you can make your selection on the Electronic Poll Book.
