The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

Following Chairperson Taylor's reading of the applications for approval, Beer Board Staff Member, Terrence Darby, informed the Board of the following:

#1 Mar and Tierra Mexican Grill – has a pending complaint, which resulted from a recently failed "Under 21 Compliance Check". This location has been operating under a temporary beer permit, which expires today. Due to the pending violation and the expiration of the current temporary beer permit, Beer Board staff requests that the Board issue an additional 30-day temporary beer permit. The complaint will be presented at the July 11<sup>th</sup> board meeting and the permit application will be on that agenda as well for final approval (pending the payment of the civil penalty).

#20 Layer Cake – the applicant's attorney has requested that this application be deferred indefinitely.

Following Terrence Darby's remarks, Chairperson Taylor entertained a motion to approve all applications except those applications listed under #1 and #20. Ms. Jarmon made a motion to approve all applications listed except for #1 and #20. Ms. Fox seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

After a brief discussion between the Board Members regarding application #1, Ms. Jarmon made a motion to extend the temporary beer permit for an additional 30 days and to defer the application to the July 11<sup>th</sup> board meeting for final approval, as requested by staff. Ms. Fox seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

After a brief discussion between the Board Members regarding application #20, Ms. Jarmon made a motion to defer the application indefinitely, as requested by staff. Ms. Glapion seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Following Chairperson Taylor's reading the applications for indefinite deferral, Ms. Glapion made a motion to defer the applications indefinitely due to missing documents. Ms. Jarmon seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

## APPLICATION FOR BOARD DISCUSSION AND DECISION

**Staff Recommendation:** Deny application based upon the owner's convictions for crimes of moral turpitude within the last ten (10) years, pursuant to T.C.A. 57-5-301(a)(1), M.C.L. 7.08.040.B.3, and other applicable state and local laws.

Chairperson Taylor informed the Board that #41 on the agenda would be held until after the complaints section.

Upon completion of the complaints section, Beer Board Staff Member Douglas James provided the Board with some background information as to why staff have recommended that this application be denied. He informed the Board the background check submitted by the owner of Alex's Tacos and Wings, LLC, Siomara Rojas, failed according to T.C.A. 57-5-301(a)(1). He informed the Board that the applicant was found guilty of all charges on February 18, 2016, and is ineligible for a beer permit for a period of 10 years from this date.

Metro Legal Attorney, Derrick Smith, also spoke on this matter and informed the Board that according to state law, this applicant does not meet the requirements for a beer permit due to the charges that were listed in the affidavit provided to all board members.



Chairperson Taylor asked the applicant, Siomara Rojas, to speak on the matter. Ms. Rojas informed the Board that she has two other locations in other counties in Tennessee. She said that those counties did approve her to obtain a beer permit despite the charges found in her background check. She informed the Board that those businesses are doing well and she has changed her life since those charges were issued.

After a brief discussion, Mr. Smith (legal) recommended that the Board defer the application for 60 days to review the information before making a decision. Ms. Jarmon made a motion to defer #41 to the August 15<sup>th</sup> board meeting. Ms. Fox seconded the motion.

Mr. Darby informed the Board that there wasn't a board meeting date on August 15<sup>th</sup>. He informed the Board that the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting in August is on August 8<sup>th</sup> and the second meeting is on August 28<sup>th</sup>.

Ms. Jarmon made a motion to rescind the previous motion for deferral of #41 to August 15<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Glapion seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Ms. Jarmon then made a motion to defer #41 to the August 8<sup>th</sup> board meeting. Ms. Glapion seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Chairperson Taylor read the complaints and staff recommendations as presented by staff.

Chairperson Taylor requested more information from the Beer Board Executive Director, Benton McDonough, on complaint #s 47 – 51, since those are not typical violations that are brought before the Board. Director McDonough informed the Board that these violations resulted from ongoing fire code violations issued by the Fire Dept, which were forwarded to us by the Fire Marshal's Office.

After a brief discussion, Ms. Jarmon made a motion to accept staff recommendations as presented. Ms. Fox seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.
