



## APPEAL OF DECISIONS

If you are not satisfied with a decision of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board regarding your application or your hearing, you may appeal the decision to the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court pursuant to the requirements set forth in T.C.A. 57-5-108. The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

Notes: Chairperson Taylor read complaints up to number 28, then paused for a discussion.

Chairperson Taylor wanted to express his concern regarding staff adding two separate violations for not checking an I.D. for both the sale of beer and tobacco simultaneously, as presented in several of the complaints read thus far. Mr. Taylor believes that these two violations should be counted as one violation, since they occurred simultaneously. Mr. Taylor did express that he expects staff to continue presenting complaints as they have been historically without prejudice, but that it is the Board’s position and authority to scrutinize and possibly make changes to these alleged violations.

Beer Board Inspector Melvin Brown explained why we cite as two separate violations. He informed the Board that not checking I.D. for the sale of beer and not checking I.D. for the sale of tobacco products are two separate offenses, because they are two separate codes being violated. He used another hypothetical example where, if a location were to sell beer, a tobacco product, and lottery tickets to an under 18 year old working under our authority, and the clerk also didn’t check I.D., there could potentially be 6 violations. One violation for each item sold, as well as three violations for not checking for I.D., although it occurred in the same instance. Inspector Brown informed the Board that we may start implementing lottery tickets in our future operations.

Vice Chairperson Jarmon requested that staff present this as another discussion with the Board at a future meeting before implementing lottery tickets into our operations.
