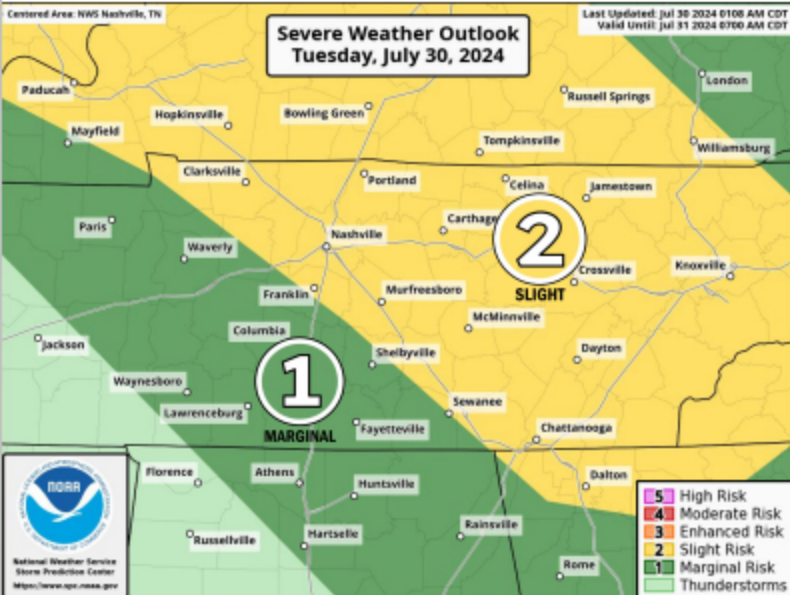

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Cluster of strong to severe thunderstorms will move in from the northwest late this afternoon and evening.
- Exact timing of severe weather is difficult to pinpoint and will be refined throughout the day.

POTENTIAL IMPACTS & TIMING

- Damaging Winds (greater than 60mph)
- Locally heavy rainfall including instances of flash flooding
- A tornado cannot be ruled out



This Afternoon and Evening

WHAT TO DO / ACTIONS

- Be weather aware and ready to act.
- Have multiple ways to receive warning information!

1 - MARGINAL
Limited in duration, coverage, and/or intensity

2 - SLIGHT
Short-lived and/or not widespread, isolated intense storms possible

3 - ENHANCED
More persistent and/or widespread, a few intense storms

4 - MODERATE
Long-lived, widespread and intense

5 - HIGH
Long-lived, very widespread and particularly intense
