If you are not satisfied with a decision of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board regarding your application or your hearing, you may appeal the decision to the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court pursuant to the requirements set forth in T.C.A. 57-5-108. The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

T.C.A 57-5-301(a)(1) Prior to making a sale of beer for off-premise consumption, state law requires identification for the sale of beer. (1st Offense x2)

M.C.L 7.08.140R It is unlawful for any beer permit holder or his agent or employee To allow or engage in any criminal activity on the premises in violation of T.C.A 39-17-1504 - Sale or distribution to underage persons unlawful - Proof of age requirement - (a) It is unlawful for any person to sell or distribute any tobacco, smoking hemp, or vapor product to another person who has not attained twenty-one (21) years of age or to purchase a tobacco, smoking hemp, or vapor product on behalf of such person under twenty-one (21) years of age. (1st Offense x2)

M.C.L 7.08.140R It is unlawful for any beer permit holder or his agent or employee To allow or engage in any criminal activity on the premises in violation of T.C.A 39-17-1504 - Sale or distribution to underage persons unlawful - Proof of age requirement - (d) A person engaged in the sale or distribution of tobacco, smoking hemp, or vapor products shall demand proof of age from a prospective purchaser or recipient if an ordinary person would conclude on the basis of appearance that the prospective purchaser or recipient may be under thirty (30) years of age on or about May 23, 2024). (1st Offense x2)

Inspector Webb provided her testimony related to the events that occurred during the "Under 21 Beer Buy Compliance Check" at this location.

Mr. Saleh informed the Board that he was training a new employee that day and he had to step away to take care of other business in the store at the time the minors entered the store. He stated that he didn't notice the 1st minor attempting to make the purchase, but did see the second minor approach the counter. At that time, he attempted to alert the new employee to check the ID, but it was loud in the store and the clerk did not hear him. He informed the Board that he has requested training from staff.

Mr. Taylor, the Chairperson, stated he doesn't agree with stacking violations of the same type, such as not checking I.D. for both beer and tobacco products. He said he expects staff to continue to charge these violations as they have statutorily, but that it is the Board's authority to make determinations as to whether to sustain these violations.

Ms. Jarmon, the Vice Chairperson, discussed the dangers of not checking IDs and minors drinking and driving. The Board decided to reduce the civil penalty due to the permit holder's pass/fail record and preventive measures implemented to reduce beer sales to minors.
