### Nashville Public Libraries

All locations have air conditioning, restrooms, and drinking fountains, as well as computers and power outlets for charging phones and other devices. - Cooling Shelter for homeless youth and young adults between the ages of 13 and 24 years old.
- Weather Assessment: Conducted at the beginning of each week.
- "Cooling Shelter" Days: Determined weekly based on weather.
- Hours: 9 AM-5 PM on "cooling shelter" days
- Services: Safe place, water, snacks
