<u>Code Provision:</u> Per IPC Table 403.1 Minimum number of required plumbing fixtures for proposed 4,000 SF structure, occupancy type A-3. An occupant load of 571, based on Assembly without fixed seats, concentrated (chairs only) calculated at 7 net per table 1004.5 requires 2 male/4 female water closets, 2 male/2 female lavatories, 1 drinking fountain, and 1 service sink. If occupant load is restricted to 100 occupants the required plumbing fixture requirements are 1 male/1 female water closets, 1 male/1 female lavatories, 1 drinking fountain, and 1 service sink.

<u>Variance Requested:</u> Requesting a variance to the requirements of IPC Table 403.1 regarding the number of permanent water closets, lavatories, and drinking fountains. Based on a maximum occupancy of 100 persons, the minimum number of fixtures required by the table is 2 water closets, 2 sinks, one drinking fountain, and one service sink.

The carport structure will be used approximately 4 times per year for community picnics, and at those times the owner proposes to rent portable toilets that are accessible and that provide the required fixtures (except for the service sink, which is not applicable with portable fixtures). Drinking water will also be provided to attendees. We request a variance to allow the use of these portable, temporary facilities when the structure is used for picnics.

It is the owner's plan to construct a separate, standalone building that will house permanent restrooms, drinking fountain, and service sink. A design is under development for this building, and it is anticipated that within two years (and possibly sooner) that building will be in place. Temporary restroom facilities will then not be needed.
