If you are not satisfied with a decision of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board regarding your application or your hearing, you may appeal the decision to the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court pursuant to the requirements set forth in T.C.A. 57-5-108. The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

Assistant Director Terrence Darby informed the Board that Inspector Hardrick, who conducted the compliance check and wrote the report, was not present. Mr. Darby proceeded to read the report into the record.

Mr. Patel did not dispute the facts presented in the report. He apologized to the Board for the incident, explaining it resulted from one specific employee's mistake; that employee has since been terminated. He noted that the business has taken steps to prevent similar incidents in the future.

Mr. Darby informed the Board that an error appears to have occurred in the cited violations. The citation included two violations for failure to check ID—one for the sale of beer and one for the sale of tobacco—which should not have been issued. According to the Inspector's report, there was no mention of ID not being checked. This discrepancy originated from a text message sent to the group during the operation, which stated that ID was not checked.

Following a brief discussion with Metro Legal representative Mr. Garth, the Board determined that the two ID-check violations should be removed, reducing the civil penalty to \$3,000: \$2,000 for the sale of beer to two minors and \$1,000 for the sale of tobacco to two minors.

Chairman Taylor entertained a motion to remove the two ID-check violations and adjust the corresponding civil penalty amounts.

Board members further discussed whether the sale of beer and tobacco should be compounded due to the fact that two individual minors purchased these items during the same transaction. Director Benton McDonough reminded the Board that, previously, an additional \$1,500 penalty was applied if beer was sold to a second minor. Following Board concerns, this practice was revised to count a second sale within the same transaction as an aggravated offense, resulting in an additional \$500 civil penalty, rather than treating it as a separate sale-to-minor violation.

After further discussion, Chairman Taylor called for a motion regarding the decision on the hearing.
