## **Glossary of Terms**

#### Physical Arrest

A custodial arrest of one person with the possibility of multiple charges. Once booked, this person may bond out, be placed on the Pretrial Release Program or remain in jail during the legal process.

#### **Bond Release**

The arrestee, or a person on behalf of the arrestee, pays a fee to a bonding company and remains out of jail during the legal process.

#### **Pretrial Release**

The arrestee is released to this supervision program and remains out of jail during the legal process.

#### Other Bond Release

The arrestee is released by other means such as cash/credit bonds, property bonds and ROR bonds in order to remain out of jail during the legal process.

#### **Boundover Warrant**

A charge that is sent to the Grand Jury once a General Session Judge decides there is reason to believe that a crime was committed by the arrestee.

#### Filings (warrant/citation)

A new case in General Sessions Court once a warrant or citation is served and booked.

#### Concluded (GS)

The status assigned to cases which have been dismissed, plead guilty to, or boundover to the Grand Jury.

#### Pending (warrants/citation) (GS)

GS pending count only includes the pending citations.

#### Criminal Information

The defendant agrees to waive the Grand Jury process, usually in return for a negotiated plea agreement in Criminal Court. The District Attorney prepares and files the Criminal Information in Criminal Court. Once filed, the Criminal Information is docketed and resolved in Criminal Court.

#### Presentments

When a case goes directly to the Grand Jury either by a 'sealed indictment' or when a General Session Judge dismisses a case and the District Attorney's Office decides to continue to prosecute the case. If the Grand Jury determines there is probable cause that the person committed the crime, the case is then set for a hearing in criminal court.

#### Indictment

The Grand Jury which determines there is probable cause that the arrestee committed the crime for which he/she is accused. The case is then set for a hearing in criminal court.

#### GS Appeal

When a defendant is convicted in GS Court, he/she has a right to a trial de novo in Criminal Court

#### Concluded (CC)

A final disposition has been decided on all counts of a case.

#### Post Conviction Events

These include probation dismissed, probation terminated, stays complete and ammended sentence events.

- \*Multiple warrants may exist for each defendant in the General Sessions Filings for Warrants and Defendants.
- \*\*Multiple defendants may exist in each case on the Criminal Court Cases and Defendants.
- \*\*\*The way post conviction defendants are counted changed in June 2014. Defendant count is totaled by defendant name, OCA, event filing date, and post-conviction event (PCE) entry type ID.
