All locations have air conditioning, restrooms, and drinking fountains, as well as computers and power outlets for charging phones and other devices. - **Showers:** Available from 6 am to 10am. People should get there at 6 AM to reserve a spot.
- **Other supportive services:** Laundry, mail service, computer, phone access and Housing and Income Resource Navigation including ID's, Birth Certificates and Education Classes.

- Hours: 9 AM-5 PM on "cooling shelter" days
- Services: Safe place, water, snacks
