APPEAL OF DECISIONS

If you are not satisfied with a decision of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board regarding your application or your hearing, you may appeal the decision to the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court pursuant to the requirements set forth in T.C.A. 57-5-108. The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

Assistant Director Terrence Darby informed the Board that Inspector Hardrick, who conducted the compliance check and wrote the report, was not present. Mr. Darby proceeded to read the report into the record.

Mr. Patel did not dispute the facts presented in the report. He apologized to the Board for the incident, explaining it resulted from one specific employee’s mistake; that employee has since been terminated. He noted that the business has taken steps to prevent similar incidents in the future.

Mr. Darby informed the Board that an error appears to have occurred in the cited violations. The citation included two violations for failure to check ID—one for the sale of beer and one for the sale of tobacco—that should not have been issued. According to the Inspector’s report, there was no mention of ID not being checked for both minors. This discrepancy originated from a text message sent to the group during the operation, which stated that ID was not checked for one of the minors.

Following a brief discussion with Metro Legal representative Mr. Garth, the Board determined that the ID-check violations and the corresponding civil penalties related to the one minor should be removed. Chairman Taylor then entertained a motion to remove the two ID-check violations and the associated civil penalties for not checking the one minor’s ID. The Board voted unanimously to remove the two violations and civil penalties for the failure to check the one minor’s ID.

Board members further discussed whether the sale of beer and tobacco should be compounded due to the fact that two individual minors purchased these items during the same transaction. Director Benton McDonough reminded the Board that, previously, an additional \$1,500 penalty was applied if beer was sold to a second minor. Following Board concerns, this practice was revised to count a second sale within the same transaction as an aggravated offense, resulting in an additional \$500 civil penalty, rather than treating it as a separate sale-to-minor violation.

After further discussion, Chairman Taylor called for a motion regarding the decision on the hearing. The Board voted unanimously to issue a \$1,500 civil penalty for the sale of beer to the two minors and a \$500 civil penalty for the sale of tobacco to the two minors.
