ACQUISITION COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED DEDICATED CONSERVATION GREENWAY EASEMENT ON PROPERTY AT 1231 PAWNEE TRAIL.

Per discussion the Acquisition Committee recommended approval of a proposed dedicated Conservation Greenway Easement on property at 1231 Pawnee Trail, Parcel # 05300001900, overlooking the Cumberland River. This greenway easement will conserve 1.97 acres of open space and provide for future expansion of the Cumberland River Greenway. The easement dedication was a condition of Metro Council's approval of Preliminary 2023SP-036-001 for a new residential development. Council District 9

Per discussion the Acquisition Committee recommended approval of a proposed dedicated Conservation Greenway Easement and Participation Agreement for a new segment of the Whites Creek Greenway located at 4267 Ashland City Highway on Parcel # 069060C04500CO.
