Per discussion the Acquisition Committee recommended approval of a proposed dedicated Conservation Greenway Easement on property at 2600 Pennington Bend Rd, Parcel #06200001200. This greenway easement will conserve 0.37 acres of open space and provide for future expansion of the Cumberland River Greenway network.
