12-24-05 Staff requests acceptance of an in-kind grant valued at approximately \$10,000 from the Nashville Parks Foundation to purchase a new water fountain for Seven Oaks Park with features including a filtered bottle filter, pet bowl, and a fully accessible design. There is no required match or other obligation by Parks associated with this grant. No money will be sent to Metro Parks. The project will be paid for directly by the Nashville Parks Foundation. NPF will coordinate all details of the project purchase with Metro Parks staff and Metro Parks Maintenance will oversee the installation of the water fountain. Council District 21

12-24-06 Staff requests acceptance of an in-kind grant in the amount of \$20,400 from the Nashville Parks Foundation for programming improvements to Metro Nashville Community Centers. The projects funded will include music equipment for youth bands, Got skills Sports Clinics, sports league sponsorships and transportation and supplies. There is no required match or other obligation required by Metro Parks associated with this grant. Council District City Wide

12-24-07 Staff requests acceptance of an in-kind grant in the amount of \$36,600 from the Centennial Park Conservancy to fund an architectural design feasibility study for the Picnic Pavilion in Centennial Park. The attached proposal from HDLA includes landscape architecture services, as well as architecture (Dryden), cost estimation (NASCO), and 3D renderings (LUNAS).
