PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

Metro Nashville will hold an open house public meeting on Thursday, April 24 from 4-7 p.m. at Nashville Cross Point Church located at 299 Cowan Street, Nashville, TN 37213 to begin implementation of the East Bank Boulevard as recommended by the [Imagine East Bank Vision Plan](#). Please drop in any time between 4:00 and 7:00 p.m. to discuss the design development and environmental process of the East Bank Boulevard.

As currently proposed, the East Bank Boulevard would follow the existing alignment of Cowan Street south from the future Cleveland Street extension (see map below) to Jefferson Street. From Jefferson Street to Korean Veterans Boulevard, East Bank Boulevard would be located on a new alignment. East Bank Boulevard would be a transit and pedestrian priority corridor and would consist of vehicular travel lanes with a dedicated transit lane in each direction, wide sidewalks and streetscaping within the right-of-way.

The purpose of this meeting is to collect feedback on the proposed East Bank Boulevard alternatives, provide community context around the Boulevard, and satisfy requirements for the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). We look forward to your valued input!
