

2025 Summer Adult Visual Arts Class Schedule

The Online Registration System completes a software update at midnight each day. Registration for Metro Parks’ Visual Arts Classes **will be available ONLINE ONLY beginning Tuesday, May 20, 2025, 12:00 a.m. CST when the system completes its daily update (at which time the blue “Sign-Up!” button will appear under the class title after you refresh your browser, and registration will be instantly live).** Please watch our videos on Facebook/Instagram for more details. Out-of-county and in-person registration will begin Wednesday, May 21, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. at Centennial Art Center. Class sizes are limited, and class availability may vary according to location. Non-county registrations on the first day may be cancelled to accommodate Davidson County residents. Registration will continue until Thursday, May 29, 2025, or until classes are full.

PLEASE notify staff prior to registering if you require any special accommodations in the studio.

Classes will begin Monday, June 2, 2025. All classes will meet once per week for **8 weeks unless otherwise scheduled.** See **NOTES below for important schedule changes.** Class times and fees are subject to change. Changes or updates will be posted on CAC's website or Facebook page.

Guidance for Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced Pottery Programs

- Intermediate and Advanced Students will not be permitted to attend Beginner Level classes.
- Required skills for Intermediate and Advanced Classes: Students must be able to demonstrate consistency in throwing 4” cylinders, apply *score and slip* techniques to assemble multi-part constructions (pots), and glaze with consistent results.
- Beginner Students will not be permitted to attend Intermediate or Advanced Level classes.

Studio fee required:1) Pottery-\$30; 2) Painting-\$5. **NO CASH.** Registered students look for an e-mail from Ashley.DelVecchio@nashville.gov containing a link to pay studio fee online on or before the first day of class. QR codes will also be supplied by your teacher on the first day of classes. These fees help offset the cost of community material and other amenities students use during class. This link will also contain a required participation waiver to digitally sign to participate in our visual arts classes.

NOTES:
1. **NO CLASSES** on Thursday, June 19th. Metro Parks facilities closed for Juneteenth.
2. **NO CLASS** week of July 4th **for this class only.**
3. **ALL POTTERY CLASSES WILL BE LIMITED TO 25 LBS (1 BAG) OF PRODUCTION PER STUDENT. POTTERY CLASSES WILL CONSIST OF 6 WEEKS OF ACTIVE MAKING AND 2 WEEKS OF GLAZING.** Please manage studio time accordingly. Kiln space and access is limited. MPVA Staff can direct you to other facilities within the community to assist your production needs. No outside work may be made or fired.
4. Pottery students: Please allow at least **TWO WEEKS after your final class** before returning to pick up pottery to ensure enough time to cycle all pottery through the various kiln firings. Designated pick-up days will be posted toward the end of the session and will be e-mailed to students.

A note about class sizes: Beginning pottery classes usually accommodate 10 students; Int/Adv pottery will accommodate up to 8 in most studios. Painting classes accommodate 12 to14 students. At this time, painting students may continue to register for a maximum of two 2 classes (or one pottery class and one painting/drawing/printmaking class). *Pottery students may register for only one pottery class per session.*
